ELIGIBILITY, DATES & TIMES: Students going into grades K-12 in the fall of 2016 are eligible to attend summer recreation, but you must be registered to do so, and you must have a current immunization record on file with the Health Office. Please use 1 registration form for each student. SUMMER RECREATION, is in session from 9:00 AM—12:00 PM each weekday from Wednesday, July 6th through Thursday, August 4th. BAND LESSONS are for 30 minutes, once a week, and are scheduled between 9:00 AM-2:00 PM. Band lessons begin Monday, July 11th and run through Thursday, August 11th. Band lessons are not given on Fridays. If registering for band lessons, please be sure to complete the middle box on the registration form. BAND LESSON REGISTRATION FORMS & PAYMENTS ARE DUE BY TUESDAY, JUNE 21st.

<u>PAYMENTS & CONTACTS</u>: Summer recreation pre-registration can be done by mail or by drop off in any office and are are requested by Friday, July 1st. Registration will also take place in the elementary gym on Wednesday, July 6th and Thursday, July 7th during summer recreation hours. **All checks/money orders must be made payable to: Barker Central School**. <u>DROP OFF/PICK UP LOCATIONS</u>: Grades K-5 must enter/exit the school through the main Pratt Elementary School entrance. Grades 6-12, must enter/exit the building behind the high school near the pool and fitness center. Supervision is provided for students to walk to/from the elementary gym and cafetorium to the HS area. This includes the pool. Bike racks are available near the Jr. HS and Sr. HS entrances. Band students will be able to enter the building at the outside band room entrance in the district parking lot on Haight Road or from the above mentioned areas. Posters and take home flyers, along with www.barkercsd.net will be used to communicate updates for activities, schedule changes or new information as it becomes available. A note will be sent home with students to notify parents/guardians of any major changes. We appreciate parent/guardian cooperation in picking up your child no later than 12:00 PM each day.

ACTIVITIES:

- Arts & Crafts—Welcome to Adventures in Art! Join in daily activities for all artistic levels and ages. Located in the elementary cafetorium students will be drawing, painting, creating in clay, and much more.
- Gym, Outdoor Activities, and Fitness Center—Students in grades K-5 will be in the elementary gym, while students in grades 6-12 will be in the HS Gym and have access to the fitness center. Fitness activities with weights and fitness equipment along with team games, individual games, tournaments, etc. will take place in these locations. Age appropriate activities like picnic games (Kan Jam, Lasso Golf, Bean Bag Toss, etc.), pick-up games, team games, nature trail walk, playground, and sport specific related activities will also take place outdoors based on interest level of students.
- Pool—Swim lessons will begin on Friday, July 8th. Students will be informed of their lesson time via postings at summer recreation on Thursday, July 7th. Lessons are every day for 35 minutes. Any free swim time will occur during lessons. Additional swim events will be determined at a later date.
- Special Events—Freeze Pop Friday (every Friday), Bike Safety Rodeo (Wednesday, July 27th), Ice Cream Day (Tuesday, Aug. 2nd), Movie Day (TBA), special games & activities. More information will be posted on the school website and/or distributed at summer recreation.

<u>OFF CAMPUS FIELD TRIPS</u>: It is recommended that students bring a bag lunch and/or are sent with an appropriate amount of money if they will need additional food. Admission, supervision and transportation are included in each field trip fee. Chaperones will not provide loans on field trips. Food, souvenirs, etc. are all at an additional expense to be paid by the student. Only the Sky Zone trip includes food.

- Sky Zone (Greece)—Thursday, July 14th. Cost is \$27.00 with a departure time of 10:30 AM and return time of 4:30 PM. Open to students going into grades 3-12. Price includes Sky Socks, 2 hours of jump time, and 1 slice of pizza and 1 fountain drink. A parent/guardian must complete a waiver form for each student. After registration & payment is made further information will be made available.
- Norfolk Tides @ Buffalo Bisons—Wednesday, July 20th at 1:05 PM at Coca-Cola Field. Cost is \$10.00. Departure time will be 11:00 AM with a return time to be determined by the length of the game. Open to students going into grades 3-12.
- Lasertron (Amherst)—Monday, July 25th. Cost is \$33.00 for 2 sessions of laser tag and 2 sessions of go-karts along with a \$10 arcade game card. Departure time is 10:30 AM with return time of 6:00 PM. Open to students going into grades 6-12 AND there are strict height requirements that must be met. All students must be at least 42" tall for Laser Tag and at least 56" tall for Go Karts. PLEASE CHECK THIS PRIOR TO REGISTERING YOUR CHILD. If a child does not meet the height requirements when we get there, he/she will not be allowed to participate in that attraction.
