Grade 1 is **Purple**

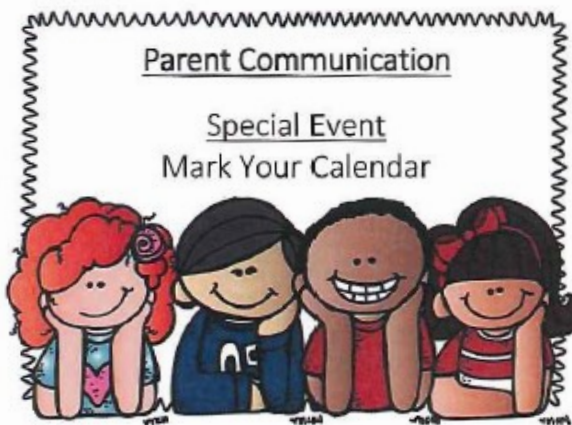
Grade 2 is **Yellow**

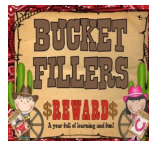
