Pratt Elementary is now using PickUp Patrol!

We have phased out paper notes for bus changes and early dismissals.

Parents are encouraged to set up an account from the PickUp Patrol emails that were sent out in September.

We do ask that you continue to provide the address to where the child will be riding the bus to in the plan change notes space, along with the phone number for the adult at that address.

If you need to know a bus number, feel free to call the bus garage at 716-795-3816.

If your child is to be excused early, please choose "Early Dismissal" from the drop down menu, and then in the next drop down menu, choose the time they are to be excused. In the notes, add why they are to be excused. That information is seen and used only by the attendance and health offices.

The cutoff time for changes is 1:00, we will not accept changes after this time.

We will **no longer** be accepting paper notes, phone calls or emails.

We will only accept phone call changes in an extreme emergency.


