To Barker Families & Students:

We had a great first day here at Barker CSD! It was fantastic seeing ALL of our students back on campus – we had full classrooms, lively hallways, and lots of sound in the building!

Parents and students: take a moment to read some of these reminders for the start of school.

- Elementary (Prek-6): if you plan on continuing to drop off/pick up your child from school each day, please do so in the district office parking lot. We allowed families to park in the elementary lot and walk their children up to the main doors today only. The elementary parking lot can become very congested so we ask that all drop offs/pickups happen in district lot.
- 2. A map of the traffic pattern for the district lot is attached to this letter.

- 4. Masks are required for all persons inside the building. Masks have to be over mouths and noses. We understand that younger students might have masks that drop down occasionally during the day – however, students (especially older ones) who are intentionally not following the guidance may face disciplinary consequences.
- 5. Students will be reviewing code of conduct outlines over the next few days. At the elementary level, this will occur in classrooms. At the high school level (7-12), grades will go to the auditorium. We ask that families also review this document. It can be found on the website. We will also be sending out a parent confirmation to sign in the next few days.
- 6. We ask that if you are having your child ride a different bus home than their normal route, please send a note in to the <u>main office one day in advance</u>. We are limited on bus runs and we have to ensure spacing is available. Also, if your child is leaving early, please send a note in on the day of or in advance.
- 10th period is not available this week except for athletes. Athletes should report to the high school gym for supervision during 10th period. Regular 10th period activities will begin next week, Monday 9/13.
