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COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Schedule

The Niagara County Department of Health will be offering FREE COVID-19 vaccine at several sites.

As of November 4, 2021 children ages **5-11** are eligible to receive **Pfizer-BioNTech** Vaccine. **Appointments are strongly recommended** and **ALL children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian**.

On December 16, the CDC recommended that **mRNA COVID-19 vaccines** (i.e., Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccines) **are preferred over the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19 for all people age 18 years or older**. This recommendation applies to **both primary series and booster doses**.

NEW! (January 5, 2022)

COVID-19 booster doses are now recommended for all individuals ages **12 years and older** as follows:

- **Pfizer-BioNTech**: All individuals **12** years of age and older at least **five** (5) months after completion of primary series
- Moderna: All individuals 18 years of age and older at least six (6) months after completion of primary series
- Janssen (J&J): All individuals 18 years of age and older at least two (2) months after completion of a one-dose Janssen primary series.

Children ages 5 - 11 years of age are **NOT** eligible for boosters at this time.

Booster doses for Pfizer, J&J and Moderna are available at each location. Pre-registration is strongly recommended.

Please use the above links to secure an appointment time. If you are unable to register online, please call 211 at 1-888-696-9211. If you are registering for a booster dose, please have your vaccine card available, you will be asked to confirm your previous vaccination dates.

Second Dose Pfizer Appointments:

All individuals attending a Niagara County DOH clinic, will be auto-registered for the 2nd dose appointment at the same location and same time as the 1st dose unless otherwise directed. Anyone that received a 1st dose at a pharmacy or other clinic should use a registration link to register for an appointment at least 21 days after the 1st dose.

Vaccination of Minors:

All individuals age 5 and older are eligible to receive a Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine. NCDOH recommends that all minors be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Providers may accept a COVID-19 Immunization Screening and Consent Form completed by the parent or guardian, where the parent or guardian is not available in person or by phone to provide consent to vaccinate. Recommendations for Boosters:

There are now booster recommendations for all three available COVID-19 vaccines in the United States. Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose. Some people may have a preference for the vaccine type that they originally received, and others may prefer to get a different booster. CDC's recommendations now allow for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.

For individuals **12**+ who received a **Pfizer-BioNTech** COVID-19 vaccine, a booster is recommended at **5 months** or more after their initial series

For individuals **18**+ that received a **Moderna** COVID-19 vaccine, a booster is recommended at <u>6 months</u> or more after completion of the initial series.

For individuals **18**+ who received a **Johnson & Johnson (Janssen)** COVID-19 vaccine, a booster shot is recommended **2 months** after the initial dose.
