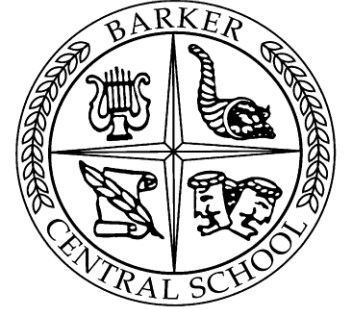

This letter contains important information for the community, our students and faculty about the Barker CSD Homecoming 2022.

- Homecoming will happen the week of Monday, September 26 through Saturday, October 1.
- Junior/Senior High students will be able to dress up as different themes throughout the week. The theme for the week is "Board Games." Information on the specific days is forthcoming for students.
- Our elementary school will also get involved. See the link at the end of the letter for more information.
- Grades 9-12 will work on their floats after school Monday through Thursday. Students should see their class advisors for more information. Float building will be completed by 7:00 pm each evening. There will be a bus Monday through Thursday at 7:00 pm to take kids home or they should arrange for their own transportation. The building closes at 7:00pm. There will still be the normal sports bus at 5:00 for any student wishing to go home then.
- Friday, September 30 has several activities for the student body and community:
 - Pep rally will be held indoors and during the school day (students only). Grades 7-12 will be in attendance.
 - Community parade: The parade will leave the Barker campus at approximately 5:15 pm. It will follow the traditional route and the community is more than welcome to spectate. Grades 7-12 will be involved, with 9-12 riding their themed floats. Route info is at the end of the letter.
 - Chicken BBQ: The senior class will be holding a chicken BBQ. They will be available for pickup at the maintenance garage on campus. More information will be announced.
 - The Barker Lady Raiders Varsity Field Hockey team will face Newfane under the lights on the athletic field at 6:30 pm.
- Saturday, October 1 is the Homecoming Dance from 7:00 – 10:00 pm in the main gym. This is for students in grades 9-12 and their approved guests. Guest forms are available in the high school main office.
