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COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Schedule

The Niagara County Department of Health will continue to offer FREE COVID-19 vaccine at several sites.

- CDC recommends everyone stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccination, including all primary series doses and boosters for their age group:
 - Ages 6 months through 4 years should get all COVID-19 primary series doses,
 - Ages 5 years and older should get all primary series doses, and updated COVID-19 boosters if eligible.
- Getting a COVID-19 vaccine after you recover from COVID-19 infection provides added protection against COVID-19.
- People who are moderately or severely immunocompromised have [different recommendations for COVID-19 vaccines](#), including boosters.
- For people ages 12 years and older, the only authorized mRNA booster is the updated (bivalent) booster. People ages 12 years and older can no longer get the original (monovalent) mRNA booster.
- [COVID-19 vaccine and booster recommendations](#) may be updated as CDC continues to monitor the latest data.

The **Novavax*** COVID-19 vaccine is authorized as a **2-dose primary series only**—and not as a booster dose—at this time.

Appointments are strongly recommended and ALL children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Booster Doses

There are now booster recommendations for all available COVID-19 vaccines in the United States. Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose. Some people may have a preference for the vaccine type that they originally received, and others may prefer to get a different booster. CDC's recommendations now allow for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.

COVID-19 booster doses are now recommended for **all individuals ages 5 years and older** as follows:

- **Pfizer-BioNTech (Monovalent):** All individuals **5 to 11** years of age at least **five (5)** months after completion of primary series. Only 1 booster is authorized for children 5 -11 years of age.
- **Pfizer-BioNTech (Bivalent):** All individuals **12** years of age and older at least **two (2)** months after completion of primary series or monovalent booster.
- **Moderna (Bivalent):** All individuals **18** years of age and older at least **two (2)** months after completion of primary series or monovalent booster.

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Please use the above links to secure an appointment time. If you are unable to register online, please call 716-278-1900. If you are registering for a booster dose, please have your vaccine card available, you will be asked to confirm your previous vaccination dates.

Second/Third Dose Appointments:

All individuals that receive a 1st dose at a Niagara County DOH clinic, will be informed of the earliest date the 2nd dose is recommended. Second/Third doses should be administered as follows:

- **Pfizer:**
 - For individuals 6 months and older that received **Pfizer**– schedule the 2nd dose **3 – 8 weeks after the 1st dose.**
 - For individuals 6 months and older that received **Pfizer**– schedule the 3rd dose **at least 8 weeks after the 2nd dose.**
- **Moderna:** For individuals 6 months and older that received **Moderna** – schedule the 2nd dose **4 – 8 weeks after the 1st dose**

Note: the registration system will display an error message if registration for a 2nd dose date is earlier than the recommended interval.

Vaccination of Minors:

All children **ages 6 months and older** are eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine. NCDOH recommends that *all* minors be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Providers may accept a COVID-19 Immunization Screening and Consent Form completed by the parent or guardian, where the parent or guardian is not available in person or by phone to provide consent to vaccinate.
