Grades

Your quarterly grade will be a combination of tests, assignments, participation/professionalism.

Tests/Projects = 70% of the quarter grade Assignments = 30% of the quarter grade

- ❖ Professionalism = 1 test grade
 - > This is a test grade based on attendance, preparedness for class, behavior in class, tardiness, other infractions.
 - 5pts deducted for each infraction)
 - Attendance—5 pts for every 3 absences
 - Cheating will result in 10 pt. deduction, a zero as a grade for that test or assignment and a phone call home. This usually involved two people!
 - Positive attitudes, helping others, attending open house, parent conferences can add professionalism points back on.
- ♦ Notebooks = 1 test grade—collected at the end of each quarter
