




#### **ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY**










#### **ELL ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY**


### **TOTAL COHORT REGENTS EXAMINATION RESULTS**

These regulations recognize the importance of engaging students' interests in rigorous and relevant academic programs in the Arts; Languages other than English (LOTE)/Billiteracy; Career and Technical Education (CTE); Humanities; Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM); Civic Readiness (CIVIC) and Career Developmental Occupational Studies (CDOS). The revised regulation allows students to use a passing score on an approved pathway assessment or successful completion of program requirements for the CDOS credential toward meeting the assessment requirements for graduation.


