YOUTH POETRY AND SHORT STORY CONTESTS

Open to all students in grades K - 12

RULES:

- 1. Youth (Grades K-12) may enter one poem and/or one short story.
- 2. Authors must be of amateur status: earnings from writings must not exceed \$500 annually.
- 3. Manuscripts entered may not have been published prior to the competition and must be original work of the author.
- 4. Entries should be written on word processors or typewriters and double-spaced, with minimum margins of 1" on all sides on 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper. Spelling counts.
- 5. Short stories limited to 2000 words.
- 6. **Poems** can be any style with a minimum length of eight lines and maximum of 50 lines.
- 7. All entries must be written during the contest calendar year.
- 8. The Six Traits of Writing will be used in the judging.
- 9. Entries MUST have the following on the TOP RIGHT HAND CORNER OF EACH PAGE:
 - author's name, email address, mailing address, telephone number
 - name of school, school address, and grade
 - name of local club, district, and state (New York State Federation of Women's Clubs)
 - Category (short story or poetry)
 - Title of work
 - Grade level category: Category 1: Grades K, 1 and 2; Category 2: Grades 3, 4 and
 5; Category 3: Grades 6, 7 and 8; Category 4: Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12
